Name Position – <u>Assembler</u>

Performs basic cable assembly work such as soldering, connector wiring, backshell assembly, ribbon cable assembly and coaxial connector assembly. Requires the proper use of soldering equipment, automatic and manual crimping tools. This is a non-exempt position.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities: Other duties may be assigned as deemed necessary.

- Follow job instructions to assemble cable assemblies from internal drawings and schematics
- Use manual and automatic crimping tools to properly crimp a wide range of terminals to wires
- Use standard measurement tools to insure proper assembly dimensions

The Ideal candidate will possess the following skills:

- Ability to follow job instructions
- Ability to read and understand drawings and schematics with assistance
- Manual dexterity and eye hand coordination to work with small parts
- Ability to use soldering equipment

- High School diploma or equivalent
- Minimum 1 year experience in cable assembly
